

WHITE HOUSE WINES

CASA LA JOYA Chardonnay Reserve 2010 - Chile	\$ 58	\$ 155	\$ 258

Medium yellow in colour with a green tinge. Ripe tropical fruits on the nose with hints of pineapple, mango and peach underlain by a touch of toasty oak. On the palate, the wine displays peach and pineapple with a nutty finish.

BLACK COTTAGE Sauvignon Blanc 2010 - Marlborough, New Zealand	\$ 58	\$ 155	\$ 258
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Bright green/yellow in colour. Aromas of lychee and gooseberries with a hint of leafy complexity. Ripe tropical fruit flavours combine with herbaceous overtones, full of concentrated fruit with lovely balance on the palate and juicy acidity to finish.

CANALETTO Pinot Grigio 2009 - Italy	\$ 58	\$ 155	\$ 258
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Pinot Grigio & Garganega together they produce a crisp, citrus wine of greater complexity, body & acidity.

RED HOUSE WINES

MARQUES DE LA CONCORDIA Crianza 2007- Spain	\$ 58	\$ 155	\$ 258
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A combination between the old & new in this Crianza with a depth of fleshy 'New World' style fruits finished with a classic 'Old World' spicy, oak aged influence. 100% Tempranillo aged for 12months in American & French oak & one year in bottle

ASPEN ESTATE Shiraz 2010 – Australia	\$ 58	\$ 155	\$ 258
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Savory notes, earthy spices and overtones of sweet brambleberry fruits and chocolate create a harmonious bouquet. The succulent palate of crushed red berries, with hints of savory characters and oak is mouth-filling but elegant.

TAHUNA Pinot Noir 2010 – New Zealand	\$ 58	\$ 155	\$ 258
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Concentrated black cherry and dark berry aromas which follow through to the palate where dark berry fruit and cherry flavours are supported by soft tannins, this is a ripe and deeply coloured food wine, designed for early drinking

GRAN VECCO Merlot Reserva 2010 - Argentina	\$ 65	\$ 168	\$ 288
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Deep ruby color aromas are cassis, sour cherry, raspberry & truffle. Some oak & leather notes may also be perceived, with moderate tannins, it is round, smooth & long-lasting aftertaste.

GRAN VECCO Malbec Reserva 2009 - Argentina	\$ 65	\$ 168	\$ 288
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Some notes of vanilla, chocolate and coffee can be perceived, as it has been aged in oak barrels. It is a full bodied wine, but velvety and with highly pleasant sweet tannins.

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WHITE WINES

CLOUDY BAY Sauvignon Blanc 2010 – New Zealand **\$ 518**

Scented and summery, the 2008 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc has deliciously vibrant aromatics that infuse the tropical fragrance of fresh passionfruit and juicy pineapples with garden-fresh basil and the spiciness of crushed tomato leaves. The palate is long and succulent, combining exotic fruits with ripe, red capsicum and a twist of green olive... beautifully complemented by crisp natural acidity and a hint of lime zest.

SHAW & SMITH Chardonnay 2008 - Australia **\$ 548**

This beautiful Adelaide Hills chardonnay gets better with each vintage. It's a gorgeously subtle white wine with a core of lemony fruit and just a hint of very smart, powdery oak. As good as new wave Aussie chardonnay gets.

BERESFORD Pinot Chardonnay NV - McLaren Vale, Australia **\$ 348**

This sparkling wine has the bouquet of lifted green apples, bread dough with a hint of cherry. Creamy mousse complements refreshing fruit flavours with a clean acid finish.

GRAN VINO SOL Chardonnay Miguel Torres 2008 - Spain **\$ 348**

Full bodied, intensely aromatic blend of chardonnay and parellada. Grassy notes with pineapple overtones. Full body and not acidic.

TAHUNA Sauvignon Blanc, 2010 – New Zealand **\$ 298**

Classic gooseberry and tropical fruit characters with fresh acidity giving focus to the fruit flavours. This is an excellent food wine and is made for drinking over 2-3 years.

DOMAINE PAUL BLANCK Riesling 2009 – France **\$ 398**

Clear, brilliant, white with pale green in color. Beautiful citrus fruits aromas, floral, honeysuckle, grapefruit. With lemony attack, fine and fresh, full mid-palate, citrus, green apple freshly cut. Long finish.

DOMAINE LAROCHE Chablis Saint Martin 2009 – France **\$ 448**

Crystal clear with hints of pale green, subtle flavors with a hint of undergrowth and citrus. Rich and aromatic, balanced by a classical mineral structure. Good harmonious persistence.

SHAW AND SMITH Sauvignon Blanc 2010 – Australia **\$ 498**

The wine is unwooded to maximize varietal punch. The aroma has restrained sauvignon grassiness coupled with riper fruit characters. The palate is fresh and lively with pure fruit varietal flavours and crisp acidity.

LES DOMANIERES ROSE 2008 Cotes De Provence – France **\$ 398**

The freshness of iodine, with citrus and honey flavours. This wine, produced from vines planted on slopes, is the delectable result of the typical blending used in Cotes de Provence wines. Brilliant and crystalline, fruity-fresh accentuated with peach and apricot, hints of white blossoms and spices.

RED WINES

- WARBURN ESTATE Cabernet Merlot 2010 – Australia** **\$ 328**
Hints of vanillin oak aromas are present on the nose, the palate has rich ripe plum, black currant and spice flavors with a fleshy texture and balances the lingering supple tannins.
- SHAW AND SMITH Shiraz 2008 – Australia** **\$ 498**
Ripened slowly and evenly resulting in intense colour, pepper spice flavours and great intensity.
- PETER LEHMANN MENTOR Cabernet Sauv. 2006 – Australia** **\$ 698**
Intense brooding blackness color & nose of opulence of classical Barossa Cabernet blackcurrants, violets. A great generosity of flavour and velvet fruit reined in by the fine chalky tannins on the finish.
- BERONIA Reserva 2006 – Rioja, Spain** **\$ 388**
Smooth from the very first touch to the lingering finish. With velvet textures, well balanced between ripe fruit flavors and drier spice elements that gives the wine a characteristic balsamy impression.
- FAUSTINO V Reserva 2004 - Spain** **\$ 418**
Medium to Full Bodied 90 - 95% Tempranillo grape giving richness and earthiness, this fine scented strawberry fruits has one year cask ageing followed by two in the bottle before release.
- BLACK COTTAGE Pinot Noir 2009/10 - New Zealand** **\$ 348**
Bursting with perfumed floral, spice and cherry notes. Wine shows finesse, balance & great length.
- LUIS FELIPE EDWARDS Gran Reserva Cab. Sauv. 2009- Chile** **\$ 298**
This deep red wine has a powerful and clear varietal nose with some floral hints that integrate well with the fine oak influences of vanilla, smoke & chocolate. Its mouth is soft, full bodied, round and has plenty of complex tastes.
- VILLA CAFAGGIO CHIANTI Classico 2007 - Italy** **\$ 448**
Dark red. Opulent aromas of ripe red cherry, sweet plum and bay leaf. Fresh, dense and juicy, with superripe flavors of red cherry and marzipan. Finishes with a persistent red fruit character.
- LE PRESI BRUNELLO di Montalcino 2003 - Italy** **\$ 548**
This beautiful, cask-aged Brunello captures an attractive mix of ripe, generous fruit wrapped inside a classically built, structured frame. The tannins are well-integrated.
- ANTARIO BAROLO DOCG 2005 – Italy** **\$ 648**
Deep ruby red with a bouquet of violet, spices and pepper. Great depth of character on the palate with classic damson fruit flavours and a good amount of spice.
- CROZES HERMITAGE DOMAINE de Thalabert 2006 -France** **\$ 728**
Intense, complex and aromatic on a blend of red berries and animal notes, deep ruby of the colour, limpid and bright, powerful and fine noble tannins; ample, well-balanced finish.
- LA SIRENE DE GISCOURS 2006 - Margaux - France** **\$ 788**
Beautiful color and brilliant cherry red. On nose this wine shows aromas of red fruits, very ripe red with delicate spice notes. On palate, this wine opens fond tannins on the finish an elegant freshness.
- CHATEAU DE SALES 1998 AOC - Pomerol - France** **\$ 1488**
Its aromatic notes are intense and complex. On the palate it's creamy with fleshiness and richness: it has fullness and good balance with clearly perceptible, but not aggressive tannins.
- MENDEL Malbec 2008 - Argentina** **\$ 448**
Great body, structure and harmony in mouth. Complex aroma, fine and present tannins with very good integrated acidity that adds freshness and relief to the wine to make it very pleasant to drink.
- MENDEL UNUS Malbec, Cabernet Sauv. 2008 - Argentina** **\$ 598**
High complexity & intensity due to 16 month of aging in new French Oak. It's fleshy and meaty fine round tanins are in great harmony with acidity that emphasize its freshness.
- TRAPICHE Malbec Single Vineyard 2007 - Argentina** **\$ 688**
Deep red garnet colored Malbec, with sweet aromas of ripe red fruits like cherry and plum. Sweet and ample in the mouth with soft and delicate tannings.
